**PE and Sport Grant 2017-2018**

A grant of £16,170 was received by Birtenshaw School in the year 2017-2018.

The grant has been used to prioritise efforts to give primary pupils a greater range of physical activities to engage in which encourage them to be more physically active, develop core strength, balance and co-ordination and help to meet their sensory processing needs through physical activity.

Part of the grant has been spent on additional equipment and part on specialist instruction.

In addition to the benefits to physical health our pupils have benefited from the opportunities to increase in confidence and self-esteem, turn-taking and social interaction thus contributing to their overall health and well-being.
